

## Access to British Canoeing UK program water at Lee Valley White Water Centre

In addition to public sessions that are available to book directly through the Lee Valley WhiteWater Centre there is the possibility to access British Canoeing UK Program water. On most weekdays there is a morning and afternoon session and a Saturday morning on some weekends. There is a maximum of 23 spaces per session, however some sessions may be restricted dependant on the needs of the programme athletes. Available spaces are allocated in the following order to Olympic Disciplines;

1. Podium or Podium Potential Athletes.
2. Qualifiers for Selection 2019.
3. International Athletes World Ranked top 30 or achieving a top 10 at U23 Championships.
4. Premier Paddlers \*

*\*usually only available in weeks where the podium program are away.*

Weekdays:

- Morning sessions (08:45 or 08:30 start\*): limited spaces available. Spaces will only be released at the start of the month, request can be put in early.
- Afternoon sessions (14:15 start\*)

Saturday:

- Morning sessions (08:45 start\*):

## Prices for Individual Passes from April 2018

There are several options to purchase vouchers to access British Canoeing Olympic Programme water:		
<b>Annual Pass (1 April 2017 – 31 March 2018)</b> this allows unlimited access to water booked by British Canoeing subject to availability.	£750	Up to £3.75 per session
<b>Summer Season pass*</b> (1 April 2017- 1 Dec 2017) this allows unlimited access to water booked by British Canoeing subject to availability.	£400	Up to £5 per session
<b>Winter Season pass*</b> (1 Dec 2017- 1 April 2018) this allows unlimited access to water booked by British Canoeing subject to availability.	£400	Up to £5 per session
<b>40 Session upfront Pass</b> (40 sessions at a reduced rate no refunds for unused sessions) .	£300	£7.50 per session
<b>20 Session upfront Pass</b> (20 sessions at a reduced rate no refunds for unused sessions) .	£200	£10.00 per session
<b>10 session upfront Pass</b> (10 sessions at a reduced rate no refunds for unused sessions) .	£125	£12.50 per session
<b>Single session Fee</b>	£15	£15.00 per session

## Home Nation Passes from April 2018

British Canoeing would like to extend an opportunity for Home Nations to purchase flexible passes. These passes will allow Home Nations to access UK Programme water slots at Lee Valley, benefiting from discounted prices by bulk buying sessions, and have the flexibility to transfer these passes across athletes.

<b>140 Session upfront Pass</b> (140 sessions at a reduced rate no refunds for unused sessions)	£1260	£9 per session
<b>100 Session upfront Pass</b> (100 sessions at a reduced rate no refunds for unused sessions)	£1000	£10 per session
<b>60 Session upfront Pass</b> (60 sessions at a reduced rate no refunds for unused sessions)	£675	£11.25 per session
<b>30 Session upfront Pass</b> (30 sessions at a reduced rate no refunds for unused sessions)	£375	£12.50 per session

## Talent Program Sessions

In addition to the access to UK Program sessions there is the opportunity for Premier and Division 1 ranked paddlers to access Talent Olympic sessions. Spaces will be dependant on the needs of the talent athletes and decided by the talent coaches. Prices are as above.
