

England Lee Valley Training – Winter 2018/19 – Block 2

England Canoe Slalom Committee have once again booked slots on Lee Valley Olympic Course during December, January, February and March to allow unfunded athletes who have qualified to compete in the Selection Trials 2019 (Juniors must be in Premier Division and minimum J15 in 2019, Seniors and U23 as per selection policy - see latest International Panel Statement) to access Lee Valley for their preparation. The sessions are for English Paddlers who are ranked with UK Canoe Slalom. *U23 athletes who have not yet qualified for Selection must still apply for these sessions NOW, but will be considered for sessions after all other eligible athletes have been allocated preferred training slots (up to the maximum available).*

This is the second block of allocations covering February and March. The dates are 9th & 10th February, 2nd & 3rd March and 9th & 10th March - 2 sessions have been secured on each date. The cost is £10 per session - 2 sessions will be allocated per athlete per day to be paid in advance; non-refundable.

You must register your interest and preference/s via the form by Monday 14th January.

Please indicate your desired dates in order of preference (in case of over subscription); two sessions will be allocated on each date indicated. The allocation of slots will be made by 20th January and payment must be received no later than 27th January 2019 via PayPal (link will be provided in the confirmation email) – if you are unable to use PayPal, please contact Nick Maingay – nickmaingay@gmail.com. Failure to pay by the stated date may result in your sessions being allocated to an athlete on the reserve list.

A policy explaining how the allocation of slots is administered is available on request and a panel of 3 independent volunteers will deal with any issues or disputes - the panel's decision is final. The panel is headed up by David Spencer – Chair of British Canoeing Slalom Committee.

Registration of interest for Juniors must be from a consenting adult and email communication regarding the sessions will be made through the adult for Juniors (NO BOOKING WILL BE ACCEPTED DIRECT FROM A JUNIOR). A responsible adult must be in attendance during the sessions for Juniors. Two coaches will be provided (where possible) by the Committee and the arrangements for each session will be explained in the notes sent out once your sessions are confirmed. Responsible adults will be expected to volunteer for safety duties (and first aid where qualified) – sessions cannot run without bank safety AND first aid.

Please note that each block of sessions is released with fair and open access to all sessions. Each block will be treated independently and no weighting will be given in respect of sessions taken or not taken in other blocks (for whatever reason) when allocations are done.
